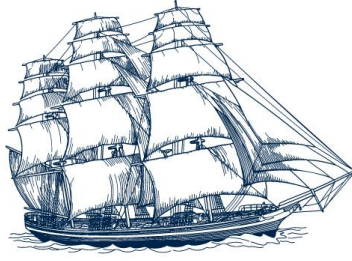

WHO MAY ENTER?

WHAT SHOULD MY ESSAY BE ABOUT?

Give your reasons for why these things would be important. In your conclusion, explain how a bank could assist a family in reaching this budget for important items.

HOW DO I ENTER?

1. Use white-lined paper.
2. Write the essay in your own handwriting or printing.
3. Do not write your name on your essay.
4. Fill out and attach the official entry form, which has been sent to your school.
5. Mail your essay and official entry form to the address indicated on the form post marked by **May 3, 2019 or hand deliver to the Bank.**

WHO WILL JUDGE MY ESSAY?

Each essay we receive will be given a code number matched to your name, so the judges will not know the author of each essay. A committee of 5 judges will read the essays. This committee will be comprised of:

1. Member of the Board of Trustees of the Martha's Vineyard Bank
2. Past principal of the MV Regional High School
3. An educator
4. A community member
